Study 2: The King dies for his people.

Readings: Luke 23:1 – 49

Romans 3:21 - 27

The story Good Friday is one we are very familiar with. As a result, it can be hard to see afresh the significance of those events.

Last week we studied the events of Palm Sunday, the arrival of Jesus in Jerusalem, acknowledge in symbolism as king yet soon rejected.

As Jesus dies on the cross Pilate in an act to annoy the Jewish authorities puts up a sign that highlights an important truth, it is our king who dies for his people on the cross.
