Readings: 1Corinthians 3

Why do think divisions may occur in the church?

Read 1Corinthians 3:

Even though the Corinthians had the Spirit, why couldn't they be considered spiritual (1Cor. 3:1- 4)?

What illustration does Paul use to describe himself and Apollos?

In verse 9 why is it significant that Paul and Apollos are God's fellow workers? Who do the Corinthians owe their allegiance?

Why is it important to be careful how you build? If it is built poorly why is the foundation so crucial?

What does Paul compare the church to in these illustrations?

In 1Corinthians 3:3 Paul accused the Corinthians of being worldly. How can he now say they are "God's Temple"?

In v10 Paul has moved from an illustration about a garden to a building. Describe the various ways the church is like a building under construction.

So why is boasting in oneself or others excluded?

What foundation is the church built on? Why is this critical?

As you think about what is taught to the Corinthians how can these lessons be applied to your life?
